NEW PROGRAMMING AT TWS

We are excited to announce that we are expanding on our successful Pathways To Independence program. This is our new **Transitioning to Triumphs** program specifically designed to assist in the community re-entry of **Veterans** and former **Offenders**. Using the biblical based *Getting Ahead While Getting Out* curriculum, this program will provide the tools to help individuals to stabilize and take charge of their lives with a healthy support network.

We will provide a year or more of mentorship and training in job readiness and financial self-sufficiency, while also making the connections to resources for housing, employment, and mental health and addiction services.
